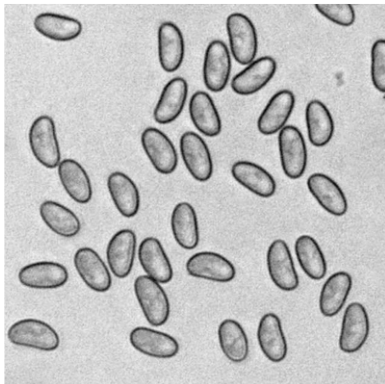

**ID:** Mixed woods. Brown (fades); conic; fibrillose/scaly; stem brown from base up.

**Habitat:** Solitary, scattered, groups. On ground/in mosses in mixed woods.

**Cap:** 0.8 – 3.5" [2 – 9 cm]

Honey-brown. Broadly conic w/ distinct conic umbo. Silky/shiny (dry) or slippery (wet) w/ radial fibers. Margin white, incurved (expanded, yellowish in age). Flesh white.

**Gills:** Whitish/grayish (coffee brown in age). Attached. Close.

**Spores:** *Brown*. Ellipsoid (one side flattened), smooth, hyaline.

**Stalk:** 1.5 – 3.5" x 1/8 – 1/2" [4 – 9 cm x 3 – 12 mm]

Whitish (yellowish in age). Smooth, silky/fibrillose; longitudinally striate.

**Frequency:** Occasional.

**Locations:** BENBR, CASCT, LONGC, TRIRS.

**Notes:** Micobank 830693. Gorman Stream Valley NRA specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.

**Synonym:** *Inocybe rimosus*. *Inocybe fastigiata*
