

<u>Tremellodendropsis tuberosa</u> Tremellodendropsidaceae



ID: Body white/buff; coral-like w/ broadly flattened branches; fused at bases.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups. On ground in hardwood/mixed forests.

Fruiting Body: 0.8 - 2.8" x 0.2 - 1.6" [2 - 7 cm x 0.5 - 4 cm] White/buff. Coral-like, densely clustered, numerous broadly flattened/ somewhat cylindrical branches; leathery/fibrous-tough; fused at bases w/tops frequently united.

Spores: White. Fusiform, smooth, hyaline.

Frequency: Unommon.

Locations: WINTR.

Notes: Mycobank 306998. Wincopin Trail specimen identified by examination of spores by R. Solem.
