ID: Magenta coral body.

Habitat: Solitary, scattered, groups. Decaying hardwoods.

Fruiting Body: Up to 3.5" [9 cm }
Magenta, reddish-purple. Erect, coral-like; forked branches arising from short stalk (upper part less branched). Smooth. Tips rounded/blunt/ tapering. Flesh reddish-purple, brittle. Radish-like taste.

Spores: White.

Frequency: Uncommon.

Locations: MANWD, MCHPV.
